FIRE PREVENTION DIVISION STREET FESTIVAL FIRE SAFETY CHECKLIST

MOBILE FOOD TRUCKS: Trailer or mobile cooking units that have a hood extinguishing system shall have a current inspection tag (within 6 months of date of event) by a licensed extinguishing company and a Class K extinguisher with a current inspection tag, prior to event.

COOKING TENTS: Shall be separated from other tents, canopies, or membrane structures by a min of 10 feet; shall have flame retardant label or certification papers; flaps shall be secured to prevent contact with cooking equipment; shall have 3 a foot spacing between tent material and equipment and shall be non-accessible to the public.

LP (PROPANE) TANKS:

- 1. All propane tanks and piping, tubing or hoses shall be undamaged, and specifically listed for use with LP gas. Damaged lines must be replaced prior to event.
- 2. LP tanks shall be stable, located outside of tents, out of workers and the public's way and valves protected from damage.
- 3. Extra LP tanks: Shall be secured in the upright position, located outside of tents, not easily accessible to the public, passing vehicles, and protected from damage.
- 4. LP Tanks shall not be located between tents
- 5. Relief valves on containers shall be pointed away from the tent, canopy, or membrane structure and other LP tanks
- 6. All containers, empty or full shall be plugged with an approved plug if not connected for use.
- 7. Containers and hoses shall not be located where it will be exposed to excessive heat.
- 8. LP gas containers shall not be located inside mobile cooking units.

CHARCOAL/WOOD COOKING: Shall have a water hose in addition to a five (5) LB minimum ABC extinguisher.

GENERATORS: Exhaust shall be directed away from buildings, other cooking vehicles, and public areas.

GASOLINE: Gasoline onsite for refueling of generators shall be in an approved container and stored a min of 3 feet away from the generator on the non-exhausting side, out of the sun.

NON-COOKING TENTS: Shall be separated a min of 3 feet from other non-cooking tents and 10 feet from cooking tents.

EXTINGUISHERS: Cooking oil operations (vegetable animal fats or oils) shall have a Class K extinguisher and a five (5) LB ABC extinguisher. All other cooking operations shall have a five (5) LB minimum ABC extinguisher. ALL extinguishers shall have a current inspection tag (within 12 months of date of event). Must be onsite prior to event.

EXTENSION CORDS: Heavy-duty all-weather cords only. No household extension cords will be allowed. All cords are to be secured and out of the public's way.
